

How to hoopla on android

To borrow items from Hoopla to read or watch on your Android tablet or smartphone, you must download the free Hoopla app from the Play Store. This app is used to borrow items from Hoopla, as well as read, listen to, or watch the title that you have borrowed. You can also visit the website to get started through your browser→ Hoopladigital.com

Sign Up

Create an account with Hoopla and follow the prompts. It will ask for your library (Saskatchewan Library Consortium).

Once your account is set up, you'll sign in with the email address and password you created.

Enter your entire library card number without spaces and your 4 numbered PIN (last four numbers of your telephone).

Search and Borrow

Search for Audiobooks, eBooks, Comics, Music, Movies, and TV. Borrow a title by clicking on the title's icon and clicking Borrow.

Enjoy

Stream the item by pressing play or download it to your device to hear, read, or watch it without Wi-Fi.

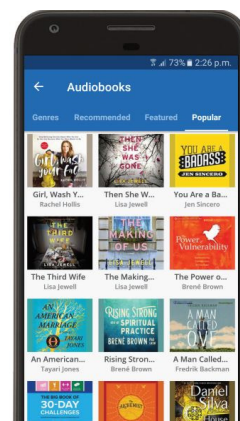
Download

To download borrowed content, simply tap on the "Tap here to download" button on the title details page. Please note that downloads are only available on the mobile apps.

You can download titles to SD cards. There is a section in your settings that allows you to select where you would like to store downloads.

Settings

To access your settings, tap on the three vertical dots at the upper right of your home screen. Then, simply tap on the download location text and choose between internal and SD card storage. This will not show up unless an SD card is inserted.
