

# How to hoopla on iOS

The hoopla digital mobile app can be found in the App Store on your iOS device. Search for "hoopla digital" to find and download the app. Hoopla will run on iOS 9.3.5 and up. For the best results, it is recommended to use the latest versions of both the operating system and hoopla app. If you don't want to install the app, you can access Hoopla in your browser by visiting [hoopladigital.com](http://hoopladigital.com)

## 1) Sign Up

Create an account with Hoopla and follow the prompts.

It will ask for your library (Saskatchewan Library Consortium).

Enter your library barcode number and PIN number. Your PIN number is usually the last 4 digits of your phone number you signed up with at the library.

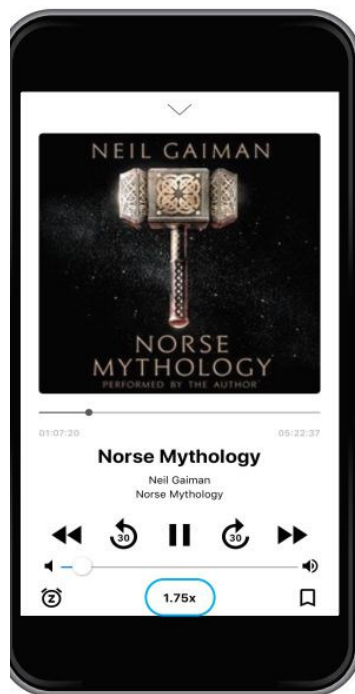
Once your account is set up, you'll sign in with the email address and password you created.



## 1) Search and Borrow

Search for Audiobooks, eBooks, Comics, Music, Movies, and TV. Borrow a title by tapping on the title's icon and tapping BORROW.

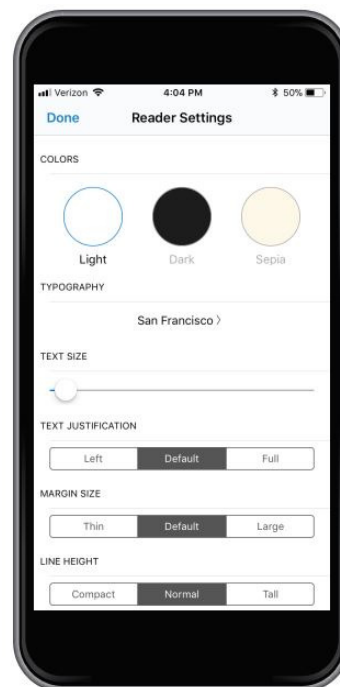
While playing the audiobook, be sure to expand the media player to gain access to all of the player controls.



## 2) Enjoy

Stream the item or download it to your device. You'll need to download it if you plan on using your item without Wi-Fi.

To download, tap the "Download to your device" option (in blue text) right below the play button. After it is downloaded, you can play the title without Wi-Fi.



Tap on "Aa" in the bottom left hand corner to access the Reader Settings menu.
